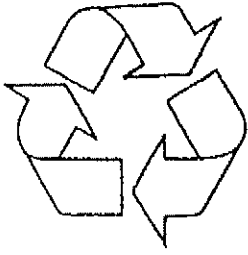
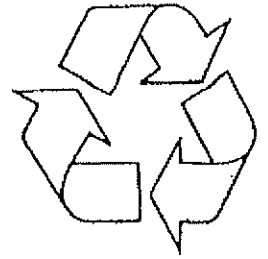

### No need to sort anymore

### Drop recycling material into marked bin portals

#### **Newspaper and Junk Mail Mix**

- Newspapers and all glossy inserts are OK.
- Keep dry for collection

#### **Magazines, Catalogs, Paperback Books, and Phone Books**

#### **White Office Paper**

#### **Cardboard, Cereal Boxes, and Paper Bags**

- Brown paper grocery bags, or same paper bags to be used for recycling paper, no bags made with plastic liners
- Staples and tape are OK
- No heavy waxed cardboard boxes, meat and fruit
- Waxed juice or milk containers are OK

#### **Plastic Bottles**

- Only bottles please
- Bottles labeled #1 (PET) or #2 (HDPE) 3,4,5,7
- Milk jugs, water, juice, and detergent bottles
- Butter/yogurt type containers, kitty litter buckets
- **No petroleum "oil based containers"**
- Rinse well and flatten; labels may be left on
- Rigid plastic accepted, buckets, toys, etc.
- **No plastic bags**

#### **Tin and Aluminum Cans**

- Aluminum and steel cans and lids
- Empty aerosols are OK
- Small scrap metals and aluminum taken
- Car and Truck Batteries, drop off at WWRA facility
- **No plastic bags, no plastic covers or tarps, no shrink wrap, no household trash, no tires.**
- **Paint cans must be empty**

### Curbside Recycling Serving Residents

- Weekly curbside pick-up for Chelsea City residents only
- Every Wednesday on the West side of Chelsea starting at 7:00 a.m.
- Every Thursday on the East side of Chelsea starting at 7:00am

- 2) 6880 Dexter-Pinckney Road at Dexter Township Hall
- 3) 20490 M-52, north of Chelsea at Vogel's Store
- 4) 11795 Dexter-Chelsea Road at Abrasive Finishing
- 5) BP Station at Fletcher Road and I-94
- 6) West Main Street, side of Manchester Market
- 7) Austin Road at Bridgewater General Store
- 8) Old Manchester Road, Chelsea
- 9) Webster Township Hall
- 10) Putnam Township Hall
- 11) Unadilla Township Hall/Police Station
- 12) Marion Township Hall, 2877 W. Coon Lake Rd, Howell

### **Used Motor Oil 24/7 drop off station outside the main gate.**

WWRA collects and recovers waste oil to heat the processing facility. This unique program not only cuts down on hazardous waste, it also saves energy WWRA accepts used motor, hydraulic, transmission, gear lube, and fuel oils for recycling. These oils may be dropped off at the WWRA recycling facility at 8025 Werkner Road in Chelsea.
