2023 Tax Information

Summer tax bills will be mailed out the first week of July and are due per Michigan Statute 211.44 by September 14th. After this date, one percent interest per month will be added to all unpaid tax bills unless a deferment has been granted per (MCL 211.905b(11) and 211.59). Summer tax deferments are available to qualified applicants. Click on the following link: Application for Deferment of Taxes or contact the township office at (734) 426-3767.

Winter tax bills will be mailed out the first week of December and are due per Michigan Statute 211.44 by February 14th. Dexter Township will accept payment of 2023 property taxes up to and including Thursday, February 29, 2024 without interest or penalty. After 5:00pm on February 29, 2024, all unpaid real property taxes must be paid to the Washtenaw County Treasurer, P.O. Box 8645, Ann Arbor, Michigan, 48107 with additional interest and penalties as prescribed by law. Tax bills are mailed to the address of record as of June 1st and November 1st of each year. Should you not receive your tax bill, please contact the township office to confirm that we have your correct mailing address on file. Per Michigan Statute (MCL 211.44), failure to receive a tax bill does not abate late payments and penalties.

Tax payments may be made at the township office during normal business hours - 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Thursday, excluding holidays, the drop box located outside the township office, the Dexter branch of PNC Bank, by electronic check or credit card at 1-844-368-5922 or www.dextertownship.org, or by U.S. mail. Please note that **postmarks are not accepted** and allow for sufficient mailing time. Electronic check payments made via Point & Pay are subject to a \$3.00 convenience fee for payments up to \$10,000.00 and \$10.00 for payments over \$10,000.00; credit card payments are subject to a 3% convenience fee. **After Wednesday, February 14, 2024, payments cannot be accepted via Point & Pay.** Upon receipt of your tax bill, partial payments may be made; however, any taxes unpaid by the statutory due dates will be subject to applicable interest and/or penalties.

The Township Treasurer is not responsible for any payments made on the wrong property and cannot transfer payment to or from any parcel or refund payments made on the wrong parcel.
