value awarded.

- Barry emailed, to the FOSP Board, the ACEP ALE (Agriculture Conservation Easement Program Agriculture Land Easements) ranking system showing the current applicants' specific rankings. Barry reviewed the ACEP-ALE information and Michigan Ranking Form with the Board.
