

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

Upgrade of Outside Warning System (OWS)

**Recommended by:**

**Explanation of Agenda Item:**

The current OWS was installed in 2012 using then current technology. That technology is now outdated. The outdated system frequently causes the reporting system to shut down, requiring manual re-start. The system is unable to retain legacy data. The current system causes 160 alarms at the Dexter Area Fire Department Station #2 during bi-annual testing. Each of these alarms has to be manually re-set by on-duty firefighters.

The proposed upgrades to the OWS would alleviate all of these issues. Monitoring of the system would be available remotely by Township Staff.

Total cost of the upgrade, if completed in conjunction with the bi-annual testing by FWS is estimated to be \$16,000.00.

# **Outdoor Warning System Proposed Upgrade**

## **History**

On March 15, 2012 an EF3 Tornado tore through the Dexter area. Approximately 100 homes were heavily damaged. Dexter Township had no early warning system in place.

In July 2012 Frontline Warning Systems (FWS) was contracted to install Warning Sirens in Dexter Township. Installation was completed in the fall of 2012, using technology available at the time. The installation consisted of 16 Warning Sirens placed strategically throughout the Township. A control panel and dot matrix printer were placed at Dexter Area Fire Department (DAFD) Station #2. Remote access was provided to the Washtenaw County Sheriff's Department (WCSD). Each Warning Siren consists of 10 redundant speaker module systems.

FWS reports there are approximately six non-test activations per year. Two examples of significant activations include a hazardous material incident involving a ruptured pipeline in Lyndon Township and an F1 Tornado occurring in Freedom Township.

## **Testing and Maintenance**

The Warning Sirens are battery operated. Solar power charges the batteries. Redundant processes ensure the system is operating properly.

- Internal Test: the system self-tests monthly. A report is generated and printed out using the dot matrix printer. The printouts are retrieved from DAFD by Township staff.
- WCSD Monthly Test: The Sheriff's Department runs an operational test monthly from March through October to ensure the system is operating properly and is audible.
- Inspection by Township Zoning Officer: In January and July of each year, the Zoning Officer visually inspects each Warning Siren location for foliage that may be blocking access to the tower, the solar panels or the speakers.
- Biannual Inspection by FWS: FWS is contracted to conduct intensive inspection of each of the 10 speaker modules of the 16 towers. Typically conducted in the spring and fall of each year to ensure each component is operating properly and batteries maintain a charge.

## **Issues with the Current System**

This OWS was installed in 2012, using technology available at that time. Some of that technology is outdated.

- Parts and supplies for the printer are becoming difficult to obtain.
- Reports have to be manually retrieved from DAFD Station #2.

- The system does not retain legacy data. When there is a failure, there is no way to retrieve lost data.
- During the monthly Internal tests, the printer frequently stops working. When this occurs, the reporting system shuts itself down. The system has to be manually restarted and the report re-run.
- During the Biannual Inspection by FWS, each time a module is inspected, it sets off a warning buzzer at DAFD Station #2. The firefighter on duty has to manually turn off the buzzer each time it is activated. There are 10 speaker modules for each of the 16 Warning Sirens (160 activations of the buzzers).
- DAFD staff do not monitor the OWS.

### Upgrade

The upgrade will have the following benefits:

- Provide continued reporting of potentially dangerous weather and other hazard to the resident of Dexter Township
- Eliminate the need for a printer, as reports will be generated and reported via email system to designated staff at Dexter Township.
- Retains legacy data.
- Allows automatic polling.
- Eliminates the activation buzzer at DAFD and replaces it with a text/email system.
- Provides ability of Township Staff to monitor the system.
- Requires an internet access at DAFD Station #2.
- Cost \$15,975.00 if completed in conjunction with bi-annual testing.

## DEXTER TOWNSHIP REDUCE, REUSE AND RECYCLE COMMITTEE

(To be referred to as the RRRC )

### Mission Statement

Dexter Township is committed to sustainability.

The RRRC is formed to contribute to the improvement of the reduction, reuse and recycling of materials that would otherwise go to landfill.

The RRRC is an educational and program committee formed to make the best use of our township resources to lead the way in sustainability.

Whereas the Township Board, with public input , has initiated a pilot program for recycling Styrofoam and film plastic .

Whereas the Township Board, with public input, has decided to implement a Reduce, Reuse and Recycle Committee to expand sustainable programs in Dexter Township.

The purpose of the RRRC is as follows:

- A. To study and educate the committee and the community about the most effective ways to reduce, reuse and recycle to be good stewards and protect our environment in Dexter Township.
- B. To provide cost efficient, sustainably appropriate programs to contribute to the current offerings we coordinate with Western Washtenaw Recycle Authority, most specifically film plastic and Styrofoam.
- C. To coordinate with other local groups providing recycle opportunities for mutual support and expansion.

### BYLAWS

As Approved by the Dexter Township Reduce Waste and Recycle Committee

As Approved by the Dexter Township Board of Trustees, \_\_\_\_\_

### SECTION I NAME

The official title of this committee shall be the Dexter Township Reduce, Reuse and Recycle Committee (referred to as the RRR Committee) .

### SECTION II MEMBERSHIP

**1. Members.** The RRR Committee shall consist of five members (including one member of the Township Board), all of whom shall be residents of the Township and appointed by the Township

Board.

**2. Term.** Each RRR Committee member shall hold office for a term of three years.

**3. Attendance.** If any member of the RRR Committee misses three (3) consecutive meetings without informing the Chair in advance of the meeting, the Chair shall advise the Township Supervisor and the Board of Trustees of the absences to be removed from the committee.

## SECTION III OFFICERS

**1.** The RRR Committee shall elect a chair and a secretary from its members. Officers will be elected by a majority of the RRR Committee members present at a regular or special meeting at which a quorum is present. Officers shall be elected for a term of one year, and each officer shall serve until re-elected or until a successor has been elected.

**2. Chair.** The Chair shall be the chief executive officer of the RRR Committee, be responsible for setting meeting agendas and preside at all meetings of the RRR Committee.

**3. Secretary.** The secretary shall be responsible for taking written minutes of the RRR Committee and deliver minutes, copies of correspondence, and notices to the Township Clerk for posting and filing (in accordance with Section 5.G.2.F of Ordinance 2005-1). If the secretary is absent from a RRR meeting, the Chair shall appoint a temporary secretary to take minutes at the meeting. The secretary may utilize a recording secretary to take and deliver the minutes of the meetings, if a recording secretary is authorized by the Board of Trustees.

**4. Legal Advisor.** The Township's legal counsel shall be the RRR Committee's legal advisor, as authorized by the Township Supervisor, unless the Board of Trustees authorizes the RRR Committee to obtain separate legal counsel.

## SECTION IV MEETINGS

**1. Schedule and Notice.** The RRR Committee shall meet at a minimum on a monthly basis at a date, place and time to be determined by the RRR Committee. The Chair or the Secretary shall notify members at least 48 hours in advance of a regular or special meeting.

**2. Rules of Order.** The RRR Committee shall use Roberts Rules of Order as a reference for rules of procedure.

**3. Open Meetings.** All meetings of the RRR Committee shall take place at the Township Hall, an Open Internet Meeting or another public place within the Township, and shall be open to the public and conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Act of the State of Michigan, MCLA 15.261 et seq., except as provided in Section 7 below.

**4. Posting.** There shall be posted within 10 days after the first meeting of the RRR Committee in

each calendar or fiscal year a public notice stating the dates, times and places of its regular meetings. Whenever the RRR Committee changes its regular schedule of meetings, the Secretary or Chair of the RRR Committee shall immediately notify the Township Supervisor and Clerk who shall post a notice of the change within three (3) days following the meeting in which the change was made.

**5. Special meetings.** Special meetings may be held as required for the proper conduct of the business of the Preservation Board at the call of the Chair or any four (4) members. Members shall be notified at least 48 hours in advance. A public notice stating the date, time and place of the meeting shall be provided to the Township Clerk for posting in the location where the Township posts notices at least 18 hours before the special meeting.

**7. Closed Sessions.** The RRR Committee may meet in a session closed to the public upon the roll call vote of 2/3 of the members of the FOSPB. The vote shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting at which the decision to hold the closed session was made.

**a. Purposes.** The RRR Committee shall hold closed sessions only for the following purposes:

(i) ANY OTHER REASON ?

(ii) To consider material exempt from discussion or disclosure by state or federal law. ( is this relevant?)

**b. Minutes.** At each closed session, the secretary shall keep a separate record or minutes that shall not be disclosed to the public except upon court order. The Secretary shall deliver a sealed copy of the closed minutes to the Township Clerk for retention. The secretary may utilize a recording secretary to take and deliver the minutes of the closed meetings, if a recording secretary is authorized by the Board of Trustees. The Township Clerk shall destroy said minutes after one year and one day have passed following the date at which the Preservation Board approved the minutes of the regular meeting at which the closed session was approved.

**c. Decisions.** No decisions of the RRR Committee shall take place in a closed meeting.

## SECTION V QUORUM; VOTING

Three (3) members of the RRR Committee shall constitute a quorum to take action on any business matter at any meeting. Except as otherwise required by law, action may be taken at any regular or special meeting at which a quorum is present by vote of a majority of members of the RRR Committee in attendance at such meeting. Decisions of the RRR Committee shall be made by majority vote.

## SECTION VI DISCLOSURE

No RRR Committee member shall vote on a project in which they have an ownership interest in any service being hired.

## SECTION VII INDEMNIFICATION

RRR Committee members shall be indemnified by Dexter Township against any liability, cost or expense, including attorney fees and amounts paid in settlement of any claim, arising out of any act or omission to act, except in the case of willful misconduct.

## **SECTION X ADOPTION; AMENDMENT**

Amendments to these Bylaws shall be by a majority vote of the members of the Reduce, Reuse and Recycle Committee. Proposed amendments to these Bylaws shall be introduced at a meeting of RRR Committee and voted upon at a subsequent meeting. Notice of the proposed change shall be published and distributed to members, said notice to include the language of the proposed change. These Bylaws and any amendments thereto shall be subject to approval by the Dexter Township Board of Trustees.

## **Dexter Township Resolution # 22-653**

### **A resolution to Approve a Styrofoam Recycling and Film Plastic Recycling Township Program for Dexter Township.**

WHEREAS, Dexter Township began cooperating with a volunteer Pilot Project, May 2021, collecting Styrofoam (weekly) and film plastic (daily) at the Dexter Township Hall in the attempt to keep the materials out of the landfill and to be recycled properly; and the community has reacted positivity and the Township believes the Program should continue, and;

WHEREAS, Dexter Township, in the interest of continuing the Project, desires to make the Pilot Project a Dexter Township Program for liability and funding purposes, as well as to formalize the structure, administration, and goals of the Program so the materials can continue to be collected in a manner to ensure the material will be properly recycled and not merely treated as trash due to its condition, and;

#### **WHEREAS:**

WHEREAS, Dexter Township will continue to work with DART and the Western Washtenaw Recycling Authority Program for Styrofoam Recycling pick up and film plastic drop off at Western Washtenaw Recycling Authority where there is a dedicated bin for film plastic, with the goal of transitioning all or a portion of the Township Program into the Western Washtenaw Recycling Authority Program, and;

WHEREAS, Dexter Township is seeking to acquire (1) 20-foot PacVan Outdoor Metal Storage Container for Styrofoam collection and (2) Film Plastic Outdoor Metal Containers so materials stay clean and dry, necessary for recycling, and;

WHEREAS, Dexter Township is seeking the donation of the 3 containers described above, but if the donation is not secured within 30 days, Dexter Township will need to secure the 3 containers necessary for the Program through lease or purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Dexter Township Board, by a vote of the majority at a regularly scheduled and duly noticed meeting held this 21<sup>st</sup> day of June 2022, gives authorization to Supervisor Ratkovich to convert the volunteer Pilot Project to become a Dexter Township Program, with an initial budget of \$15,000.00 from the Dexter Township General Fund, to be operated at its current location.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Dexter Township Supervisor, or the Supervisor's Designee, shall be solely responsible for the administration of the Program, with contracts and/or purchases subject to Township Board approval where required by the Township purchasing policy.

It is also the intention of Supervisor Ratkovich or the designee to form an Environmental Committee with the goal of involving community, directing and setting guidelines for Dexter Township Recycling Program

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Dexter Township shall continue efforts to secure a donation of the 3 containers required to operate the Program, but if no donation is received by June 21, 2022, the Administrator of the Program may seek proposals for the purchase or lease of the 3 containers described above.

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED THAT discussions with the Western Washtenaw Recycling Authority regarding its acquisition of the Dexter Township Film Plastic Recycling Program, and, if feasible, the Dexter Township Styrofoam Recycling Program, shall continue. With the goal of generating income to the WWRA too continue to supply and improve recycling practices.



## Dexter Township Board of Trustees

### RESOLUTION # 22-655

Dexter Township Board of Trustees, Washtenaw County met on the 16th day of August 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

Present Board Members: Diane Ratkovich, Michelle Stamboulellis, Maris Metz, Karen Nolte and Laura Sanders

The following resolution was offered by member \_\_\_\_\_ and supported by member \_\_\_\_\_.

**WHEREAS**, on August 1, 2022, Tribar Manufacturing LLC (Tribar), a company located in Wixom, MI, divulged to Michigan's Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) that the company had released several thousand gallons of a liquid containing 5% Hexavalent Chromium into the Wixom Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) on or before that date; and

**WHEREAS**, in recent years, Tribar was identified as the primary source of liquids containing PFAS/PFOS being released into WWTP, resulting in widespread contamination of the Huron River System from Wixom all the way to where the river meets Lake Erie, causing local and state health authorities to issue a "No Eat Fish" advisory affecting that same area for almost four years since being discovered, an advisory that remains in effect to this day; and

**WHEREAS**, this recent release of Hexavalent Chromium, a known carcinogen, has resulted in advisories including No Swimming, No Wading, No Fishing, No Drinking Water, No Using Water for watering plants or lawns, No Eating Fish, and No allowing pets in the water from the point of entry in Wixom to Kensington Rd. in Livingston County, advisories that could be expanded to include the entire Huron River system downstream of the release; and

**WHEREAS**, these releases of harmful chemicals by Tribar into WWTP have already caused long-lasting damage to the environment and may cause even worse damage if Hexavalent Chromium is found in the waters downstream of the release; and

**WHEREAS**, the residents of, and visitors to, the areas affected by these harmful releases now live in fear of the harm, to themselves, their children, and their pets, that may result from enjoying the simple pleasures of recreating in and around the Huron River and the Huron River Chain of Lakes, which includes many of our Township's residents; and

**WHEREAS**, EGLE is responsible for protecting the environment, our residents, and visitors, as well as the wildlife of our beautiful State from such harmful releases; and

**WHEREAS**, our elected officials, including the Governor, the Attorney General, and our state and federal legislators are sworn to protect the residents of the State of Michigan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE DEXTER TOWNSHIP BOARD:**

1. Demands action from EGLE, and our elected officials, to prevent any future releases of harmful chemicals by Tribar, or any other company, into WWTP, or any other such facility, that might result in the contamination of the environment.
2. Calls for the immediate disconnection of Tribar from the WWTP while investigations continue into the careless procedures that are causing releases of harmful chemicals into the Huron River system.
3. Demands that such disconnection remain in effect until such time that safety procedures are tested and proven to prevent releases of harmful chemicals into the WWTP.
4. Demands that Tribar be prosecuted to the full extent of the law for the negligent procedures that resulted in these releases of harmful chemicals.
5. Demands that EGLE require all Significant Industrial Users (SIUs) have an approved Industrial Pretreatment Program (IPP) in accordance with Part 23 rules.
6. Demands that Wastewater Treatments Plants, including WWPT, that discharge into the Huron River System, do not provide service to SIUs unless and until they meet the requirements of the municipality's approved IPP.
7. Demand EGLE assess fees and fines to the maximum extent possible to Tribar to be dedicated to improvements and enhancements of the Huron River ecosystem.
8. Demand that the Wixom Police Department, in conjunction with EGLE, MDHHS, MIOSHA, the Oakland County Sheriff Department and Michigan State Police, conduct a thorough criminal investigation into all elements related to the Tribar Hexavalent Chromium spill and seek criminal prosecution through the Oakland County Prosecutors Office.








**Zoning Permits Issued & Closed- Year-to-Year by Month.** *(All numbers are for July.)*

During the month of July 2022 there were 181 calls for service (including traffic stops). Deputies conducted 85 traffic stops during this time with 18 citations issued.

Noteworthy events in Dexter Township during last month include:

On July 18<sup>th</sup> Deputies responded to the Pinckney Recreation Area for a Larceny from Auto. The victim advised that when they returned to their vehicle, they found the window broken out and items removed from the vehicle. Deputies attempted to recover a stolen cellphone from the vehicle but were unable to locate it.

On July 30<sup>th</sup> Deputies were dispatched to the intersection of N Territorial Road and W Huron River Drive for a motorcycle crash. Witnesses reported that the biker fell off his motorcycle and was seriously injured. Deputies arrived and found the 59 year old Dearborn Heights resident in the roadway with obvious injuries. While making contact, Deputies detected a strong odor of intoxicants coming from the rider. A search warrant was authorized for the rider's blood and lab results are pending.

#### Banked Hours Update:

The collaboration accumulated 176 banked hours during the month of July. The banked hours were generated due to a vacant shift. 297 banked hours were used to fill vacant shifts and for extra traffic / bike patrols. As of the end of July, the collaboration has a yearly banked hours balance of 88.75 hours.
