This has become an especially hot issue today, as there have been [new voting laws that include](#) broad, sweeping changes being passed across the country that makes voting more difficult. For one, you can become a poll worker. According to one survey cited by the Center for American Progress, in 2018, nearly 70% of U.S. jurisdictions had difficulty [finding enough poll workers](#). This has become exacerbated as we are in the middle of a worsening pandemic.

Without enough poll workers, lines to vote at [polling locations become longer](#) and it becomes more difficult to cast a vote.

While the 2020 election had the greatest voter turnout in the 21<sup>st</sup> century, with [17 million more people voting](#) than in 2016, this only amounted to about 67% of the American population. Turned on its head, that means a third of eligible Americans did not vote. In addition, 73% of qualified citizens were registered to vote, but this also means 27% of available citizens were not registered at the time.

In addition to being a poll worker, you might want to be a part of a campaign to register qualified voters. Alternatively, you can volunteer to shuttle people to and from polling locations.

### **Help Wounded Veterans**

Wounded and disabled veterans have selflessly sacrificed of themselves but frequently have needs that are not provided for.
